GARBAGE & RECYCLING INFORMATION:

SOLID WASTE (garbage) – limited to two 35 gallon containers per week.

MUST be at curb by 6:00 a.m. on morning of day marked “G” on calendar. NO EXCEPTIONS!

BULK PICK-UP – limited to TWO items each week on THURSDAY!!!

RECYCLING – ALL recycling will be picked up every other Wednesday - MUST be at curb by 6:00 a.m. on morning of day marked “R” on calendar. Recycling is a “single stream” process. That means that you place ALL recyclables at curbside on the same day and ALL recyclables can be placed in the SAME container – paper, glass, plastic, etc.

PLEASE BE COURTEOUS AND REMOVE ALL TRASH CANS FROM CURBSIDE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF GARBAGE/RECYCLING PICKUP.

REMINDER: As of Jan. 1, 2011, landfill disposal of electronics is prohibited. Our hauler can no longer accept electronics at curbside. Our hauler also cannot accept household hazardous waste such as lead or oil based paint, stains, thinners, pool chemicals, mercury, fluorescent bulbs, rechargeable, button or lithium batteries. These items must be taken to the SCMUA at 34 Route 94, Lafayette, NJ 07848.

Vegetation-Mulch & Compost Sussex County residents can hand load regular mulch and compost for free.

Note: Household single use batteries such as AAA, AA, C, D, 6V, 9V, and 1.5V No longer have to be recycled.
