MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

5K Run PTA - The Green Hills School PTA has requested the use of EverGreen Park and the County Connector Trail to hold a 5K run. The Bicentennial Committee has recommended this event to the PTA as a way of promoting Green Township's Bicentennial celebration. Date of the event is September 22, 2024, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with a rain date of October 16, 2024. Food trucks, bounce house, obstacle course, lawn games, music, face painting, and vendors are planned. This request will be approved unless there are objections.

Dog Waste EverGreen Park - As reported by the Superintendent of Public Works, Jason Miller: "Recently, there has been a noticeable problem with dog owners not picking up after their pets. This negligence has resulted in our DPW workers frequently encountering dog waste while performing their duties in the park. This not only poses health risks but also creates an unpleasant environment for park visitors. Furthermore, there has been an increase in the number of people walking their dogs without leashes. This poses a safety hazard to other park users, including children and other pets."

We recommend additional signage posting the rules and regulations and increase social media posts concerning the proper behavior of animals that use the parks. If this condition persists further action could be considered.

Court Shared Service - The current shared service agreement for Municipal Court with the Town of Newton expires on December 31, 2024. We will pursue a new agreement with the Town of Newton and vet through the Joint Municipal Court Subcommittee. (Raffay, Qarmout)

911 Shared Service - The current shared service agreement for 911 emergency communications system management with Sussex County expires on December 31, 2024. We will pursue a new agreement with Sussex County and vet through the Emergency Services Sub-Committee. (Phillips, Raffay)

Old Forge Lane Holiday Request - The Township received the following request:

Many people from around the county and the state visit Old Forge Lane between Thanksgiving and New Years Eve to take in the holiday decorations, meet and take pictures with the characters (6), and donate food (325 food items collected last year). Every house goes up and above with their decorations each year.

We were wondering if the town could add a sign that sits above the Old Forge Lane street sign that reads Christmas Lane. We would look to have that up starting Thanksgiving week through the end of the year. We can maintain it after that. Please advise if this is possible.

Wayne Dietz states "I am fine with it. The actual name of the street should be prominent above all but ok to add seasonal sign..."

After discussion, the Committee authorized the holiday signage.

NJDOT Municipal Aid Project: Yellow Frame Road - Cory Stoner has submitted the 2025 Municipal Aid application for the milling and paving of Yellow Frame Road. The Engineer's cost estimate is \$236,400.00 with a total requested amount of \$250,000.00.

Municipal Vehicle - Bids for a Ford Explorer will be opened on Tuesday, July 30th at 10:30 a.m.

Movie in the Park - The Recreation Committee has scheduled a Movie in the Park for Saturday, July 27th starting at 8:30 p.m. The Pixar film Cars will be the featured movie. The Recreation Committee has invited Dolly Jingles Ice Cream truck to provide for the sale of ice cream (allowed under Chapter 9-12). Vending or exposing for offering for sale any article, thing or service shall be prohibited, exception shall be made for any nonprofit organization who has obtained approval for this activity from the Township Committee or their designated agent.

A discussion ensued regarding the criteria for a background check which will be looked into.

Sussex County Day - Sussex County Chamber of Commerce is offering complimentary exhibit space on Sussex County Day, September 15th. As stated, it's an excellent opportunity to meet with the public and showcase your municipality, share the latest news, solicit support for your upcoming projects, and attract new residents. Does the Township Committee see value in the attendance of said event?

A discussion ensued regarding representation from possibly the Bicentennial Committee or Historical Society.

Sussex-Warren Energy Cooperative - The Co-op has announced that a recent energy auction has resulted in a reduced rate (Standard Option) of \$0.1119/kWh and a choice to select 100% Renewable Energy (Green

Option) for fractions of a penny more at \$0.1196/kWh. Two (2) information sessions are scheduled one via Zoom on Tuesday, July 23 at 6:00 p.m. and in person on Wednesday, July 31^{st} at 6:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building.

Use of Facilities Request - The Lake Tranquility Thunderbolts swim team will be hosting the annual swim meet at Lake Tranquility on July 27th from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. The request is to allow directional signage within the local roads and one side of the street parking. This request will be approved unless there are objections.

A discussion ensued concerning the ability to be able to get emergency vehicles through the streets. The Lake Tranquility will work with the Superintendent of Public Works for proper signage.

Fire Department Grant Award - The Green Township Fire Department has been approved for a FEMA grant of \$27,500 for the purchase of 6 sets of structural turn out gear. This grant will help with yearly compliance on replacing old out for date gear with newer safer gear. This was one of two grants that the fire department applied for with FEMA and are still waiting for the results of the second grant.

Affordable Housing - There will be a more in-depth discussion at the next meeting but for now we will direct Habitat to focus their due diligence on the two (2) properties previously discussed and not to involve additional lots.
