### MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

Hunts Pond Road - The plans for the Hunts Road Embankment Improvements have been submitted to the NJDEP. Comments have been received and Pellow has addressed most with a few concerns lingering. The plan is to receive quotes after all NJDEP concerns are met. The hope is to have time this year for construction, but it might lapse into next year. We just need to have the grant monies incumbered before years end.

**Bicentennial Tree Planting** - There is a request to plant a tree at the municipal building celebrating Green Township's bicentennial. The proposed location is in the grass area in the northwest corner of the parking lot.

Mayor Phillips commented that Gardens of the World provided a variety of recommendations and will donate the tree to the Township. The Bicentennial Committee recommends a native maple tree. Once the brush is cleared the tree will be planted.

Smokefree Signage in EverGreen Park - We have received signage for EverGreen Park concerning smoking from the Center for Prevention and Counseling. The Committee authorized the installing a couple of signs at the municipal parks.

**Pickleball Court** - The new pickleball court at EverGreen Park is complete and open for use. At this time a containment fence is not installed but will be considered in the future. We encourage everyone to go to the park and check it out.

Memorial Benches - The three new benches have been installed around the flagpole at EverGreen Park. The patio block will be thoroughly cleaned. Some areas may have to be reset.

*Insurance* - The Township Clerk stated that over the past few weeks two workers comp have been filed and one tort claim concerning flooding.

#### MATTERS FROM THE GOVERNING BODY:

Raffay stated she stated received phone calls regarding the reassessment. It seems that several residents were letting neighbors know that the inspectors were in the neighborhood. The

homeowner stayed home to accommodate the inspector however the inspector did not show up. Mayor Phillips stated that in looking at schedule on the Township website the inspectors are not canvassing the entire road, they are moving around the Township.

Raffay referred to a letter received from the Millburn Mayor regarding forming a coalition of towns to collectively address the important matter of affordable housing obligations. The Township Clerk commented that each town is required to pledge \$10,000.00 to join the coalition. The Committee's opinion is to draft a letter in support of the coalition with no monetary contribution.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: The Township Attorney stated that for the second round there were many municipalities that did pay into the consortium and was successful. The Township Attorney will review the resolution and report back to the Committee.

Jennifer Martinez commented that she is at her wits end with the home she purchased from Habitat for Humanity that the Township previously owned. Jennifer provided further comments and concerns about the multiple flooding events on her property.

The Township Attorney stated that there is an active tort claim; Wayne Dietz's office is working on.

The Township Clerk will send the first tort claim information to Jennifer.

Mayor Phillips stated that she truly feels for what Jennifer is going through. Flooding situations and the way water goes may not be related to the Township.

Josephine Fracasso commented that the interest rate for the vehicle is very high. Josephine asked why the Township must go through bids; can the Township just purchase a vehicle through a dealership. Mayor Phillips stated that there are bid thresholds. The Township Clerk responded that there are fair and open processes to follow.

There being no further public comments offered, Mayor Phillips closed Open Public Session #2.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREEN, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY, COVENANTING TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED, APPLICABLE TO THE EXCLUSION FROM GROSS INCOME FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES OF INTEREST ON OBLIGATIONS ISSUED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF GREEN AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CLERK/ADMINISTRATOR, CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER AND OTHER TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS TO TAKE SUCH ACTION AS THEY MAY DEEM NECESSARY OR ADVISABLE TO EFFECT SUCH COMPLIANCE AND DESIGNATING A \$285,600 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE, DATED AUGUST 8, 2024, PAYABLE AUGUST 7, 2025, AS A "QUALIFIED TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATION" PURSUANT TO SECTION 265(b)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Township of Green, in the County of Sussex,
New Jersey (the "Township") from time to time issues bonds, notes and
other obligations the interest on which is excluded from gross income
for Federal income tax purposes and desires to take such action as
may be necessary or advisable to establish and maintain such
exclusion; and

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), contains provisions with respect to the exclusion from gross income for Federal income tax purposes of interest on obligations, including provisions, among others, which require issuers of tax-exempt obligations, such as the Township to account for and rebate certain arbitrage earnings to the United States Treasury and to take other action to establish and maintain such Federal tax exclusion; and

WHEREAS, the Township intends to issue a \$285,600 bond anticipation note, dated August 8, 2024, and payable August 7, 2025, (the "Note"); and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to designate the Note as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Green, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Township Committee hereby covenants on behalf of the Township, to the extent permitted by the Constitution and the laws of the State of New Jersey, to do and perform all acts and things permitted by law and necessary to assure that interest paid on bonds, notes or other obligations of the Township (including the Note) be and remain excluded from gross income of the owners thereof for Federal income tax purposes pursuant to Section 103 of the Code.

SECTION 2. The Mayor, Clerk/Administrator, Chief Financial Officer and other officials of the Township are hereby authorized and directed to take such action, make such representations and give such assurances as they may deem necessary or advisable to effect compliance with the Code.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 3}}$ . The Note is hereby designated as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" for the purpose of Section 265(b)(3) of the Code.

SECTION 4. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the Note is not a "private activity bond" as defined in the Code and (2) the Township and its subordinate entities, if any, do not reasonably anticipate issuing in excess of \$10 million of new money tax-exempt obligations (other than private activity bonds) during the calendar year 2024.

SECTION 5. It is further determined and stated that the Township has not, as of the date hereof, issued any tax-exempt obligations (other than the Note) during the calendar year 2024.

SECTION 6. The Township will, to the best of its ability, attempt to comply with respect to the limitations on issuance of taxexempt obligations pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code; however, said Township does not covenant to do so, and hereby expressly states that a covenant is not made hereby.

SECTION 7. The issuing officers of the Township are hereby authorized to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the original purchaser of the Note and to further provide such original purchaser with a certificate of obligations issued during the calendar year 2024 dated as of the date of delivery of the Note.

SECTION 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately

upon its adoption.
