MINUTES:

Approval of minutes of May 24, 2016:

Motion to approve the May 24th minutes with amendments was made by J. Wilson, second by C. Moyano. All in favor, motion passed.

REORGANIZATION:

- Reappointment of R. Vohden was tabled until the next meeting.

COMMUNICATION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- C. Licata presented the memo regarding the NJ League of Municipalities Convention to M. Fox. M. Fox reviewed the memo with the committee and anyone who is interested in attending should let C. Licata know before July 11th.
- C. Licata shared the DEP new release about controlling mosquitoes in the Municipality. The committee reviewed and decided to post the announcement as is.

LAND USE BORAD UPDATE:

- J. Wilson gave an update from the last Land Use Board meeting. The Board approved the Eisenmenger application, Block 16, Lot 23 for a detached garage. The application was before the board for a use variance and bulk variance.
- J. Wilson also commented that the Board created 3 Advisory Committees, Application Review Committee, to determine completeness of an application before it brought to the full board. The Technical Review Committee and an Ordinance Review Committee.
- M. Muller commented that the Technical Review Committee met last week to review applications for the 7th Day Adventist for an expansion on their gym and for Airside.

- M. Fox updated the committee that the school is building a new playground and would like to remove trees to add two fields. The school will be in touch with the Zoning Officer to see if they will need tree removal permits.

PROJECTS:

- Conservation Easements- M. Fox will provide an article for the fall Green Grapevine.
- Macro-Invertebrate project. The committee met at the Pequest River on June 18th and conducted the Macro-invertebrate study. The committee collected various different types of critters and the final analysis is that the water is clean. C. Licata informed the committee that R. Vohden suggested to contact the person from DEP to obtain information on what date would be the best to perform the study and to send out information about the project. R. Vohden also suggested that the DEP could help with the study next year.
- Invasive Species project- J. Wilson will provide C. Licata with links for the website to help inform the residents on Invasive Species. J. Wilson will send pictures of samples of invasive species which will be printed out for Green Twp. Day.


