- Garden maintenance schedule devised. Fausto Moyano motioned to approve the schedule, seconded by Cynthia Moyano; all in favor, motion carried.


NEW BUSINESS: Installation of sign at second pollinator garden discussed. It was decided to have Jason Miller move the sign to face the trail.
