

GREEN TOWNSHIP ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2026, AT 5:30 pm

ROLL CALL: Michael Wood, Cynthia Moyano, Fausto Moyano, Ellen Lessin were in attendance. Christopher Sullivan was absent. Also in attendance was Green Township resident Donna Grafanakis, and Gwen Santos, Committee Secretary. Matt Fox arrived after roll call. The meeting was called to order at 5:40 pm.

MINUTES: Minutes read by Mike Wood. Motion to approve the minutes of February 3, 2026, meeting was made by Fausto Moyano, seconded by Matt Fox; all in favor, motion carried.

COMMUNICATION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS: None

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- **Reorganization (tabled from February 3, 2026, meeting):**
 - Nomination for Matt Fox to continue as the Vice-Chair was made by Fausto Moyano, seconded by Cynthia Moyano; all in favor, motion carried. Matt Fox accepted the nomination by reading and signing the Oath of Office as Vice-Chairman.
- Elly Lessing presented information on ANJEC Grant Program: After review, it was determined to petition the Township Committee for permission to apply for said grant.
- Project Summary spreadsheet was reviewed and recommendations for changes were made **by** Members. Mike Wood reviewed necessary changes with secretary, who will make adjustment for next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Members voted to participate in Clean Communities Day on April 18, 2026. Five (5) members will be in attendance. Form was completed by Mike Wood and returned to the secretary to give to the Clean Communities Coordinator, Patty DeClesis.
- Mike Wood will make a request to be added to the agenda for the Township Committee meeting on April 6, 2026, and prepare a presentation to request approval to apply for the ANJEC grant.

PUBLIC COMMENT AND/OR QUESTIONS: Just prior to the close of the meeting, Mike Wood recognized Donna Grafanakis, who proceeded to address the committee by voicing her concerns regarding the proposed construction of a cell tower on the former Trinca Airport location. Mrs. Grafanakis was advised that no contract for the build is in place; that the Township Committee only voted to accept bids for the proposed action. She was also advised that this would need to be approved by the Land Use Board, and that this could be a lengthy process and may not be fulfilled for quite some time.

ADJOURNMENT: Motion to adjourn was made by Matt Fox, seconded by Elly Lessin. All in favor, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:45 pm.
