Mrs. Peralta has sent letters to three different companies to obtain updated quotes.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: Mr. Stein met with Mr. Dennis McConnell, Sussex County Counsel with regards to the 517 right of way. The survey prepared by Mr. John Miller's office shows the right of way as 55 feet. An old survey that Mr. McConnell had found shows the right of way at 33 feet. Mr. Stein will look further into the dedicated right of way.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND/OR QUESTIONS: Mr. Josh Weinstein, 251 Kennedy Road, first thanked the Committee and gave credit for a great town to live in. Mr. Weinstein is an advocate for Trinca Airport. He is also a pilot and has concerns of the obstruction of trees that obscure the pilots' view of the runway. Mayor Conkling stated that the Township will check into.
