Mrs. Phillips commented that Student Government Day is one of her favorite days and a great opportunity to share information with the students.

Mr. Chirip thanked Mr. Zschack, the department heads and all those that participated in the day.

Mayor Conkling stated that there will be an upcoming meeting with the Township Engineer, Mr. Zschack, Mr. Perigo and Mr. Caruso to begin discussions on the trail to get some recommendations concerning the surface. Mayor Conkling commented the student essays were well written this year. To get better participation we will look into changing the day

Mrs. Phillips referred to the resolution requesting the BPU to investigate problems after the recent storms. After reading a draft resolution and subsequent events that have occurred, Mrs. Phillips does not think it makes sense to move forward with that resolution. No specific areas have been identified as problem areas. One concern is the tree problems that are on the opposite side of the road where power lines are.

Mrs. Raffay stated that she attended a BPU meeting and spoke on behalf of Green Township. The BPU representatives seemed extremely concerned about what was being said and stated there will be change.

Mr. Chirip recommended inviting our JCP&L representative to provide a debriefing concerning the recent power outages, what their findings were and action plan to alleviate some of the problems.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack thanked the Deputy Clerk for coordination of Student Government Day.

Clean Communities Day is scheduled for this Saturday, April 21, 2018 (Rain date April 28th). E-waste collection will be from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. New this year will be paper shredding 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Please keep in mind that the Financial Disclosure Statements need to be filed before April 30, 2018.

The bid opening for the Fire Alarm System will be held on Friday, April 20, 2018, at 11:00 am and is open to the public.

The Township has received two quotes for the opening and closing of gates at EverGreen and Papa Park. We just want to make sure that the Township Committee wants to continue the same practice of locking the gates at night and closing the park while snow is present on the walking trail. A brief discussion was held on whether the park should remain closed during the winter months. The Committee will review again in September and consider the possibility of closing the park for the winter months. A resolution authorizing the opening and closing of the park gates will be considered for the next meeting

On March 19th there was a discussion concerning a request to purchase land near the EverGreen Trail. The direction was to look into a possible lease of the land. In the case of a lease to a private person, said lease must be made to the highest bidder by sealed bids. Therefore, the parcel to be leased would need access from Kennedy Road. Mr. Zschack stated the Tax Assessor cannot provide market value, would need a separate appraiser. Mr. Bolcato stated that a public auction bid or a sealed bid would need to be completed for leasing township property. After a brief discussion, the Committee is of the opinion that selling the property is not practical at this time. The property should be continued to be owned by the Township for potential future need. Mr. Chirip suggested looking into what farmers would pay to rent property. Mr. Zschack will speak with the property owners to see if they would consider a lease.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: No matters for discussion.

MATTERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT HEAD: Mr. Perigo stated that wood chipping will begin the week of April 23, 2018. Street sweeping will begin shortly. Gates for Papa Park are on order. Mr. Perigo recommends the Committee consider the bathrooms when deciding what to do with the open and closing the gate.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND/OR QUESTIONS:

Mrs. Josephine Fracasso, 111 Hibler Road, commented that many residents thought the website, Nextdoor Green Township, was very efficient and helpful during the recent storms and power outages and recommends using the Township website for information. Mrs. Fracasso also noted that many people were upset during the warmer weather days that the gate at EverGreen Park remained closed. Mrs. Fracasso recommends having the DPW open and close the gate to eliminate paying someone, or just leave the park gate open.

Section 4. No officer or employee shall be entitled to receive an additional increment of salary until the same has been approved by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 5. The Township Committee reserves the right to pay a salary to any new employee during his or her probationary period of ninety (90) days which may be less than the minimum rate of salary or compensation as herein above provided. However, upon the satisfactory completion of such probationary period said employee shall be paid not less than the minimum salary provided for the particular office or employment.

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-04 TOWNSHIP OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

Section 6. The Township Committee further reserves the right to pay a salary to any new employee at any figure between the minimum and maximum salary provided for such office or position and not necessarily the minimum salary.

Section 7. The adoption of this Ordinance shall not operate to either increase or decrease the present pay of any officer or employee of the Township of Green, and the salaries or compensations provided by existing ordinances shall remain in full force and effect until such time as the Township Committee may grant and approve such additional increments of salary as may be deemed advisable pursuant to the terms of this Ordinance. A resolution of the Township Committee establishing specific salaries or wages may be made retroactive to January 1st of the year in which the resolution is adopted or may establish the date on which salary shall take effect.

Section 8. Salaries shall be paid in the manner and the same time as heretofore provided by ordinance.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as prescribed by law.

Section 10. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which may be inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance, are to the extent of such inconsistency hereby repealed.
