CALL TO ORDER

The April 27, 2015, meeting of the Green Township Committee was called to order at 7:10 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ADEQUATE NOTICE: Mrs. Peralta read the statement of adequate notice.

ROLL CALL: Present: Mr. Chirip, Mr. Conkling, Mr. Kurzeja, Mrs. Phillips, and Mr. Reinbold

Also present: Mrs. Linda Peralta, Clerk/Administrator; Mr. Richard Stein, Township Attorney, Municipal Department Head, Mr. Watson Perigo; and Mrs. Patty DeClesis, Deputy Clerk

Resolution of Appreciation to Roy Aull – Mayor Phillips read the resolution recognizing Mr. Roy Aull.

DISCUSSIONS:

- a. **Advanced Field Maintenance Contracts** – Mrs. Peralta stated that on March 24, 2015, bids were opened for the field maintenance and clay management which included two alternatives for the advanced clay management field treatment mechanical. The Township has 60 days to award a contract or not. The Committee discussed how to proceed. Mrs. Peralta will ask the Viersma’s for an extension. If they agree we can see how things go this summer before determining whether the fields are in need of the advanced treatment. The Committee is in agreement.
- b. **Lake Tranquility Community Club Donation of Block 45, Lot 1** – Mr. Stein explained the Lake Tranquility Community Club (LTCC) had offered to donate the lot that they purchased some years ago from the Township. A title search was done. LTCC does not have an attorney or money to pay an attorney to prepare the closing documents. Mr. Stein offered to donate his time and services. There is a deed restriction limiting use of the property for recreational purposes for members of LTCC. This deed restriction would have to be released. Mr. Reinbold has concerns that this may set an example for other property owners that may have land that they cannot use or build on and do not want to pay property taxes on that portion. The Committee felt that a decision could be made on a case by case basis.

Mr. Chirip motioned to accept the donation with the Township Attorney preparing the closing documents.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK/ADMINISTRATOR: Mrs. Peralta noted the following:

- Presentation by the Township Auditor, Mr. Tom Ferry to review the 2014 audit. The Committee has 45 days to review the audit and sign the affidavit. The presentation can be done at the next Committee meeting on May 27, 2015, however the CFO, Mrs. Linda Padula is not available. After a brief discussion, the Committee would prefer to change the meeting to May 28 to accommodate Mrs. Padula.
- Mr. Rich Vohden is unable to attend Student Government Day and participate in the tour of Green Township for the students on May 13, 2015. Mayor Phillips stated that she and Mr. Conkling have previously led the tour in Mr. Vohden's absence and they would be available this year.
- Sussex County Day is Sunday, May 3, 2015, at the Sussex County Community College, 12:00 to 4:00 p.m.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: Mr. Stein noted a letter from the Administrator in Jefferson Township regarding their Tax Assessor, Mr. Shawn Hopkins, with regard to a suit that he has filed. Mr. Hopkins has filed OPRA suits against every town in Morris and Sussex Counties over tax assessment electronic records. Mr. Stein is in the process of attempting to settle the suit.

MATTERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT HEAD: The wood chipping started today. The DPW is still sweeping township roads and repairing the catch basins. There are a large number of sinkholes that they are also repairing. Mr. Perigo looked into the wall at the old firehouse. It was recommended by several masons and the building official not to use keystone block because of the salt that is used on the parking lot. Their recommendation is a poured concrete wall. Mr. Perigo will continue researching.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND/OR QUESTIONS:

Mr. Bob McCafferty, 47 Forest Road – commented on the closing of the soccer fields at EverGreen Park in order to protect and maintain the fields. He feels the fields should remain open so that kids can play on them year round.





Section 4. No officer or employee shall be entitled to receive an additional increment of salary until the same has been approved by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 5. The Township Committee reserves the right to pay a salary to any new employee during his or her probationary period of ninety (90) days which may be less than the minimum rate of salary or compensation as herein above provided. However, upon the satisfactory completion of such probationary period said employee shall be paid not less than the minimum salary provided for the particular office or employment.

Section 6. The Township Committee further reserves the right to pay a salary to any new employee at any figure between the minimum and maximum salary provided for such office or position and not necessarily the minimum salary.

Section 7. The adoption of this Ordinance shall not operate to either increase or decrease the present pay of any officer or employee of the Township of Green, and the salaries or compensations provided by existing ordinances shall remain in full force and effect until such time as the Township Committee may grant and approve such additional increments of salary as may be deemed advisable pursuant to the terms of this Ordinance. A resolution of the Township Committee establishing specific salaries or wages may be made retroactive to January 1st of the year in which the resolution is adopted or may establish the date on which salary shall take effect.

Section 8. Salaries shall be paid in the manner and the same time as heretofore provided by ordinance.


Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as prescribed by law.




