DISCUSSIONS:

- a. **Ultralight Pilot Aircraft Use of Trinca Airport Draft Policy** – Mrs. Peralta explained the Airport Manager, Mr. Pete Sklannik, drafted a policy for ultralight pilots to use Trinca Airport. Mayor Phillips thought the policy is too cumbersome. The policy is not clear on who would be responsible for opening and closing the gate at the airport, who would get a key to the gate, and who would be responsible for reserving time slots. Mrs. Peralta suggested creating a permit process for ultralight pilots. The ultralight pilot would be charged a fee and required to supply a Certificate of Insurance. Mr. Conkling suggested the person who currently opens the park and the cemetery, Mr. Bob Cahill, may be able to also open and close the airport each day. After a brief discussion, the Committee would like to see what Mr. Cahill will charge to open and close the airport each day and discuss further at the August 8, 2016, meeting.
- b. **Advanced Field Treatment** – The fields have not had very much usage this past spring. The Committee discussed the alternatives. After a brief discussion, it was suggested to go with Alternate D – Advanced Field Treatment Mechanical with Total Lawn Care. A resolution authorizing the contract will be available for the Committee’s consideration at the next meeting.
- c. **Fire Alarm, Card Access, Surveillance System and Burglar Alarm Systems for the Municipal Building** – The Committee reviewed plans and drawings for the Municipal Building. Mr. Stein will put together bid specs for the Committee’s review at the next meeting.
- d. **Appointment of Animal Cruelty Investigator (Draft Resolution)** – Mrs. Peralta explained an incident that occurred at 231 Pequest Road involving pigs running at large and being treated inhumanly. The Animal Control Officer was called to the property. The incident prompted this draft resolution to appoint an Animal Cruelty Investigator. The Animal Control Officer, Mr. Alan DeCarolis, has the credentials to be the Animal Cruelty Investigator. This would allow an incident to be handled in-house as opposed to getting the SPCA involved.

CORRESPONDENCE: Mrs. Peralta noted the following:

- Email from a resident complimenting Mr. Randy Gould, DPW. Mr. Gould had removed a very large tree limb that had fallen on the property and blocked the driveway.

MATTERS FROM THE GOVERNING BODY: Mr. Chirip inquired about an ordinance for temporary signs in the Township.

Mr. Conkling had no major complaints about the bike race that was held this past weekend. The one complaint is that the riders are crossing the double yellow lines when making turns. Mayor Phillips indicated that police presence at the intersections created safe conditions for the riders and the vehicles.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK/ADMINISTRATOR: Mrs. Peralta noted the following:

- **Requests to Attend New Jersey League of Municipalities Conference in November 2016** – Two requests from employees that would like to attend the Conference. Committee approved the requests.
- **Trinca Airport** – Mr. Conkling and Mr. Qarmout have not met with Mr. Tremper. Mrs. Peralta noted that Mr. Tremper is not paying his full amount of rent per month. Mr. Tremper was notified that Fire Safety needs to inspect the inside of the maintenance garage. Mayor Phillips stated that she would like written correspondence to go to Mr. Tremper about him not paying the correct rent amount since January 2016. Mayor Phillips asked Mr. Stein about the draft Trinca Airport Incident Report what happens if this is an OPRA document if someone checked to remain anonymous, does the name and address get redacted. Mr. Stein explained that under the OPRA rule if someone requests anonymity, their identity would not be revealed to the OPRA requestor. The content would be revealed. Mayor Phillips asked if the anonymity is exposed is the Township liable and should there be a disclosure statement on the form that anonymity is not guaranteed. Mr. Stein’s answer was no.
- **Update – Old Firehouse/Greendell Post Office** – Mr. Perigo will begin the project once the oil and stone project is completed and the fence installed at the airport.
- **Land Use Ordinance** – The Land Use Board will review the new checklist for Land Use applications at their meeting this week. It is anticipated that the new Land Use Ordinance and Checklist will be available for the Committee’s review prior to the August 8, 2016, meeting.
- **Large events happening in town** – Mrs. Peralta became aware that large events are happening in town involving a large number of attendees. There is concern that the First Aid Squad, the Fire Department and State Police are not aware that these events are happening. Emergency Services need to be notified particularly if there are more than one event held in the Township on the same day. Mrs. Peralta drafted a Public Event Notification form for the applicant to complete if the event is anticipated to have 300 or

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: Update - Lake Tranquility Bridge – Mr. Stein prepared a letter that will be sent to the contractor that built the bridge as well as the subcontractor of the manufactured the prefab bridge.

8 Michael Court – Mr. Stein and Mrs. Peralta explained the difficulty of trying to contact the correct party with regards to the condition of the property. The Committee discussed collecting the registration fees and the next step of issuing summonses for failing to comply with the Ordinance. Mr. Stein will make one final attempt to contact the bank and then issue the summonses.

MATTERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT HEAD: The Road Department will begin oiling and stoning Henry Road, Hibler Road, Autumn Ridge Road, Old Pond Lane and Brookside Lane.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND/OR QUESTIONS: Mr. Neil Kenny – 82 Hibler Road asked if the meeting is being recorded and if he can obtain a copy of his comments. Mr. Stein advised that Mr. Kenny would be able to obtain a copy. Mr. Kenny proceeded to inform the Committee of an incident that occurred on July 1, 2016, at the Hibler Road and Henry Road intersection involving three members of the Green Township Volunteer Fire Department. Mr. Kenny would like the Township Committee to conduct their own investigation of the event. Mr. Stein thanked Mr. Kenny for his comments.

Mrs. Josephine Fracasso – 111 Hibler Road made the following comments:

- Mentioned an incident that occurred during Hurricane Sandy with her husband and Chief Rafferty. Mrs. Fracasso feels that the Township's money should not be given to the Fire Department.
- Commented that Mr. Cahill would pass Trinca Airport to open the cemetery gate. Why would the Township pay extra to open the gate at Trinca Airport. Mayor Phillips explained that the Township will look into how much Mr. Cahill will charge before making a decision.
- It may be easier to lock the second door of the entranceway and a visitor would need to be buzzed in rather building a wall. Mayor Phillips explained the Committee is reviewing many suggestions.
- Mrs. Fracasso complained that the Municipal Building phones are not being answered. It is very frustrating to keep getting voicemail.

Mayor Phillips thanked Mrs. Fracasso for her comments.

Mr. Neil Kenny – 82 Hibler Road suggested adding video technology at the second glass door at the entranceway, keeping that door locked. The Receptionist would be able to view someone at the door and buzz the visitor into the building. Mr. Conkling explained that the idea is to protect the employees but to keep the open town hall. The Committee will review prices before making a decision. Mayor Phillips thanked Mr. Kenny for his suggestion.

WHEREAS, Mr. DeCarolis has duly completed the Animal Cruelty Investigator course pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:23A-2.7; and

WHEREAS, Mr. DeCarolis has been duly certified as an Animal Cruelty Investigator pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:23A-2.8; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Green wishes to appoint Mr. DeCarolis as its Animal Cruelty Investigator in conjunction with his prior appointment as Animal Control Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Green that Alan DeCarolis is hereby appointed Animal Cruelty Investigator for the Township of Green; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. DeCarolis shall further continue his appointment as Green Township’s certified Animal Control Officer.

3. Ms. Mantz will work a full time (35 hours per week – Monday through Friday 8:30 to 3:30 – summer hours to be determined by Administrator) schedule.
4. Ms. Mantz will perform Land Use Board Secretary duties as outlined in the General Ordinances of the Township and will perform such other duties (including but not limited to processing clerk – Recreation Secretary, zoning support, smoke certs support, DPW support) as may be assigned.
5. Upon successful completion of the coursework for Board Secretary, Ms. Mantz will receive an increase of \$3,000.00 in annual base salary.
6. Ms. Mantz is eligible, as a full time employee, to participate in the Health Benefits plan for the employee only.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the MCCPC is to provide substantial savings on various goods and services to its members through the cooperative public bidding process; and




