Ar. Pete Sklannik, Airport Manager has scheduled a training session, on Thursday October 19th, for the Green Township Fire Department and First Aid Squad on the safe deactivation of ballistic parachutes. The FAA will provide an Instructor to orientate Green Township's first responders on the safe deactivation of ballistic parachutes.

The water at one tap at the municipal building has tested positive for Total Coliform for a second time within a year. A Level 2 Assessment must be performed by Suburban Engineers which also includes a corrective action plan. Different purification systems are under review but could cost approximately \$10,000 to install.

It is that time of the year again for the Committee to consider if any RFPs are warranted for Township Professionals. Last year it was in the rotation to consider the Township Planner but due to retirements, RFP's were issued for the Township Attorney and Engineer.

Green Township Day is scheduled for this Saturday, September 23rd from 12:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. Over 30 venders have signed up for this year's event which also includes Games, a Bounce House, Obstacle Course, Photo Booth, Cotton Candy, Popcorn, free Ice Cream from Cliff's and food for sale from Chefs. We encourage all township residents and the local community to attend this event.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: One matter to be discussed in Executive Session.

MATTERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT HEAD: Mr. Perigo noted the following:

- Brush trimming will be completed soon.
- Crack sealing will begin in early October.
- The Road Department is in the process of sweeping excess stones from Township roads that were recently oiled and stoned.

Mr. Zschack explained that there is some potential in the Lake Tranquility community. Elizabethtown Gas will consider if there is interest from the online survey. Mr. Kaphan inquired about a noise ordinance regarding roosters on a property nearby. Mr. Zschack will look into the zoning regulations for that area.

Mrs. Josephine Fracasso, 111 Hibler Road - asked for an explanation on the process of rotation of the professionals. Mayor Phillips explained the process of rotating the services of the Township's professionals.

Mrs. Fracasso commented how nice it is that many people are using EverGreen Park.

ORDINANCE DELETING SECTION 2-5 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE REGARDING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINSTRATOR AND AMENDING SECTION 2-4.3 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE REGARDING THE MUNICIPAL CLERK DUTIES

- WHEREAS, the Green Township Committee feels that it is in the best interest of the Township and citizens to consolidate the positions of Township Clerk and Township Administrator; and
- **WHEREAS,** under Section 2-5.2 of the Township Code, only the Township Clerk may be appointed as Township Administrator; and
- **WHEREAS**, the duties of the Township Clerk and Township Administrator are presently being performed by the same individual; and
- **WHEREAS,** Township Ordinance 2017-06 provides for an annual compensation of \$36,400 for the position of Township Administrator and an annual compensation of \$46,800 for the position of Municipal Clerk/Registrar; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. § 43:15A-25.2, a public employee with more than one position eligible for participation in the Public Employee Retirement System will only receive pension credit based on the highest-paid position; and
- WHEREAS, under the Township's current system for appointing a Township Clerk and Township Administrator, the individual appointed is unable to receive pension credit for both the position of Township Administrator and the position of Municipal Clerk/Registrar; and
- WHEREAS, it is contrary to the Township Committee's intent for one individual to serve as both the Municipal Clerk/Registrar and Township Administrator and to receive only partial pension credit; and
- WHEREAS, the Township Committee finds that the Township Administrator duties should be absorbed with the Township Clerk duties, to provide for a fully pensionable position;
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Green as follows:
- **SECTION 1.** Section 2-5 of the Township Code, entitled "Township Administrator" is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- **SECTION 2.** Section 2-4.3 of the Township Code, entitled "Duties", shall be amended by the addition of a new subsection, which states as follows:
 - j. The Municipal Clerk shall also exercise all duties of a Township Administrator, as provided by N.J.S.A. 40A:9-136.
